- SR should be practising in a Capital Market Services License (CMSL) company; have an agreement with the CMSL company to practise financial planning and advisory services for a minimum of 24 months.

PROGRAMME ENTRY REQUIREMENT

- Have a minimum of 3 years' full-time working experience in a financial-related industry
- Hold a CFP, CIFP (Part 1), RFP, Shariah RFP, or
- Be a member of MIA, MICPA, CFA (Aust.), ACCA, Bar Council, ICSA, MAICSA, CIMA, or
- Have a relevant PhD, Masters or Bachelor's degree
